CIRCUMSTANCES OF ARREST

On 02/11/2010 at approximately 1152 hours, LVMPD Patrol Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] San Pedro Ave. reference a white male beating a female in the street. When Officer A. Fink and Sergeant D. Schofield arrived, they saw a baby stroller upended in the street. A small child (approximately 3 months old) was lying in the street. Officer Fink said it was obvious that the child was dead. A female was by the baby. The female was also injured but she was sitting up. Officer Fink and Sergeant Schofield were directed by citizens/witnesses to the residence located at [REDACTED] San Pedro Ave. Officer D. Cienega and other officers arrived seconds later. As the officers were watching the house, a white male, later identified as Harold Montague, came outside. Montague held his hands about head high and yelled at the officers "What the f--- do you want". Montague charged at Officer Cienega and said he was going to kill him. Montague grabbed Officer Cienega's shotgun and attempted to pull it away from him. Montague hit Officer Cienega while attempting to get the officers shotgun.

Montague could not get the shotgun from Officer Cienega. Montague attempted to run back inside the house, however, Officer A. Fink fired his taser at Montague striking him in the lower back. Montague was taken into custody and was later transported to Sunrise Hospital by paramedics. While Montague was being handcuffed, Officer Fink said a child approximately 5 years old, walked out of the house.

The officers searched the residence to determine if there were any other injured people in the residence. Officers located a small child, approximately 3 years old (later identified as [REDACTED] Montague) sitting in a highchair, in the livingroom. [REDACTED] was transported to Sunrise Hospital by paramedics. [REDACTED] was examined by the medical staff at Sunrise Hospital. The medical staff determined [REDACTED] did not have any injuries.

The officers located a female, later identified as Monica O'Dazier, in the southeast bedroom. O'Dazier was obviously mentally and physically challenged. She was bleeding from her waist area. Officer Fink picked O'Dazier up from her bed and carried her outside to the paramedics.

The Female in the street, later identified as Sandra Lisset Castro. She was transported to Sunrise Hospital with multiple head injuries. Castro was taken into emergency surgery.

The infant child in the street, later identified as Damien Avila-Castro DOB 08/27/2009, was pronounced dead at the scene by Clark County Coroner's investigator Rod Heriford.

Detectives Wildemann and Bunn spoke with Mae Garner and Teresa Garner. They each told the detectives they saw a Hispanic female (Sandra Lisset Castro) pushing her baby stroller up the street. They saw the man that lives across the street (Harold Montague) start hitting Sandra Castro and Avila-Castro with an axe. Teresa Garner said she went out her back door and stayed behind the gate and yelled at Montague to stop. Montague did not stop hitting Castro and her infant son. Teresa Garner said she watched as Montague ran into his home located at [REDACTED] San Pedro Ave. As the police arrived, she directed them to Montague's home:
