The undersigned J. Hudson - SALT LAKE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, Agency Case No. 09-128377, upon a written affidavit states on information and belief that the defendant, ALEXANDER BLOOMFIELD, committed the crime of:

COUNT 1

CRIMINAL HOMICIDE, MURDER, 76-5-203 UCA, first degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 19, 2009 at 1309 South Stewart Street, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant, a party to the offense, intentionally or knowingly caused the death of another; and/or intending to cause serious bodily injury to another, the actor committed an act clearly dangerous to human life that caused the death of another; and/or acting under circumstances evidencing a

depraved indifference to human life, the actor knowingly engaged in conduct which created a grave risk of death to another and thereby caused the death of another; and/or the actor was engaged in the commission, attempted commission, or immediate flight from the commission or attempted commission of any predicate offense, or was a party to the predicate offense to wit: aggravated burglary, and a person other than a party as defined in Section 76-2-202 was killed in the course of the commission, attempted commission, or immediate flight from the commission or attempted commission of any predicate offense.

NOTICE IS GIVEN pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §76-3-203.1, that the defendant is subject to an enhanced penalty as provided in that section because the above offense was committed in concert with two or more persons.

COUNT 2

AGGRAVATED BURGLARY, 76-6-203 UCA, first degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 19, 2009 at 1309 South Stewart Street, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant, a party to the offense, entered or remained unlawfully in a building or any portion of a building with intent to commit an assault on any person and in the course of attempting, committing, or fleeing from said burglary the defendant, or another participant in the crime,

- (a) caused bodily injury to any person who was not a participant in the crime;
- (b) used or threatened the immediate use of a dangerous weapon against any person who was not a participant in the crime; or
- (c) possessed or attempted to use any explosive or dangerous weapon.

NOTICE IS GIVEN pursuant to Utah Code Annotated §76-3-203.1, that the defendant is subject to an enhanced penalty as provided in that section because the above offense was committed in concert with two or more persons.

COUNT 3

PURCHASE, TRANSFER, POSSESSION OR USE OF A FIREARM BY RESTRICTED PERSON, 76-10-503(2)(a) UCA, second degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 19, 2010 at 1309 South Stewart Street, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant did intentionally or knowingly agree, consent, offer, or arrange to purchase, transfer, possess, use, or have under his custody or control, or did intentionally or knowingly purchase, transfer, possess, use, or have under his or her custody or control any firearm and:

- (i) has been convicted of any violent felony as defined in Utah Code §76-3-203.5;
- (ii) is on probation or parole for any felony;
- (iii) is on parole from a secure facility as defined in Utah Code §62A-7-101.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE:

Your Affiant bases this information on the following report 09-128377:

On or about July 19, 2009, at 1309 South Stewart Street, Officers responded to a report of shots being fired. Officers entered the home and discovered that Krystal Flores had been shot in the head.

The statement of Detective Hudson that witnesses identified PAILATE LOMU and ALEXANDER BLOOMFIELD as the two individuals who kicked open the door and entered the residence. Witnesses also stated that the first man, later identified as defendant LOMU, had a handgun and was wearing a white t-shirt and black gym shorts. Witnesses stated that the second man, later identified as defendant BLOOMFIELD, had a rifle and was wearing a blue t-shirt. Witnesses also stated that Krystal Flores was shot by the man with the rifle. Police recovered a .22 caliber shell casing from the scene, and have determined that Ms. Flores was shot with a .22 caliber weapon.

Krystal Flores was hospitalized until August 2, 2009, when she died from her injuries. Dr. Todd Grey with the State of Utah Office of the Medical Examiner determined the cause of

death of Krystal Flores to be a gunshot wound to the head, and the manner of death to be homicide.

The statement of GEORGE BLAKE ANGILAU that he and defendant PAILATE LOMU drove to the area of 13th South and Stewart Street to meet up with Shannon Malia Moala, Nitokalisi “Nick” Fonau, and defendant ALEXANDER BLOOMFIELD, to retaliate for a prior shooting against defendant LOMU. ANGILAU admitted that he was in possession of a handgun, and fired the handgun at a rival gang member while acting as a lookout.

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 46-5-101 (2007) I declare under criminal penalty of the State of Utah that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my belief and knowledge.
